

Christmas in the Cabin

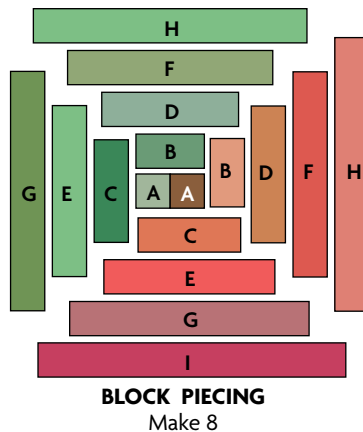

Here's an easy-to-do, quick-to-quilt scrappy project that will spruce up your holiday table. Designed and made by Jen Daly of Grantham, New Hampshire, *Christmas in the Cabin* is a great way to use some of those red and green fabrics in your scrap basket.

ASSEMBLY

1 Wash, starch and press fabrics. Make templates for L and M/Mr from template plastic and transfer the grainlines. Cut the patches listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.

2 Referring to the block piecing diagram, join a brown print A to a green print A. Press the seam allowance toward the green print A. Stitch a green print B to the top of the unit and press the seam allowance toward the B. Then stitch a red print B to the right side of the unit and press the seam allowance toward the red print B. Continue adding patches C-I as shown, always pressing the seam allowance toward the patch you just added to make a block. Make 8 blocks. ▶



MATERIALS AND CUTTING

Requirements are based on 40" fabric width.

BLOCK SIZE: 9"

QUILT SIZE: 22" x 54"

MATERIALS	YDS.	CUTTING
Red Prints	½	8 B, 8 C, 8 D, 8 E, 8 F, 8 G, 8 H, 8 I
Green Prints	1	8 A, 8 B, 8 C, 8 D, 8 E, 8 F, 8 G, 8 H, 20 I, 8 J, 24 K
Brown Print	⅛	16 A
Tan Prints	¼	16 B, 6 L, 2 M, 2 Mr
Binding	⅓	5 binding strips 2¼" x 40"
Backing	1¾	1 panel 26" x 58"
Batting		26" x 58"

ALSO NEEDED: template plastic

TECHNIQUES USED: machine piecing, piecing with templates, pieced borders, hand quilting



CHRISTMAS TABLE RUNNER
FREE PATTERN

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3 On a design wall or large, flat surface, and referring to the quilt assembly diagram, arrange the blocks as shown. Take care to orient the blocks correctly. Join the blocks in rows then join the rows.

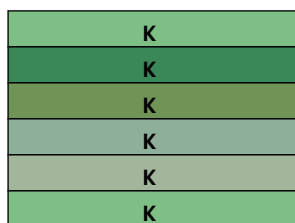
Join 4 green print I's end to end then join to the side of the quilt. Repeat for the other side.

4 Referring to the band diagram, join 6 K's to make a band. Make 4 bands. Referring to the cutting diagram, cut 2 L's from each band.

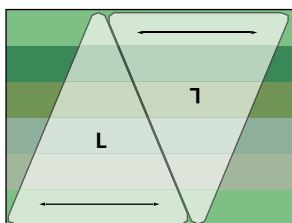
5 Referring to the border piecing diagram, join 4 green pieced L's, 3 tan print L's, 1 M, 1 Mr, 4 brown print A's, 8 tan print B's and 4 green print J's to make a border. Make 2 borders. Join a border to each end of the quilt.

6 Join 6 green print I's end to end and join to the side of the quilt. Repeat for the other side.

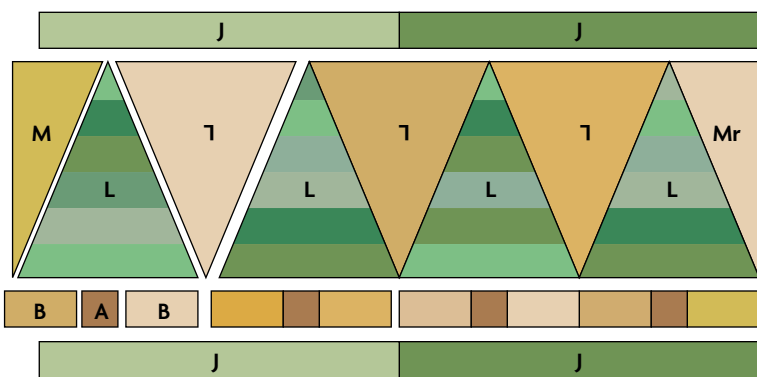
7 Mark quilting motifs as desired. Jen Daly quilted the blocks in the ditch and did straight-line quilting in the borders. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste. Quilt as marked or as desired. 



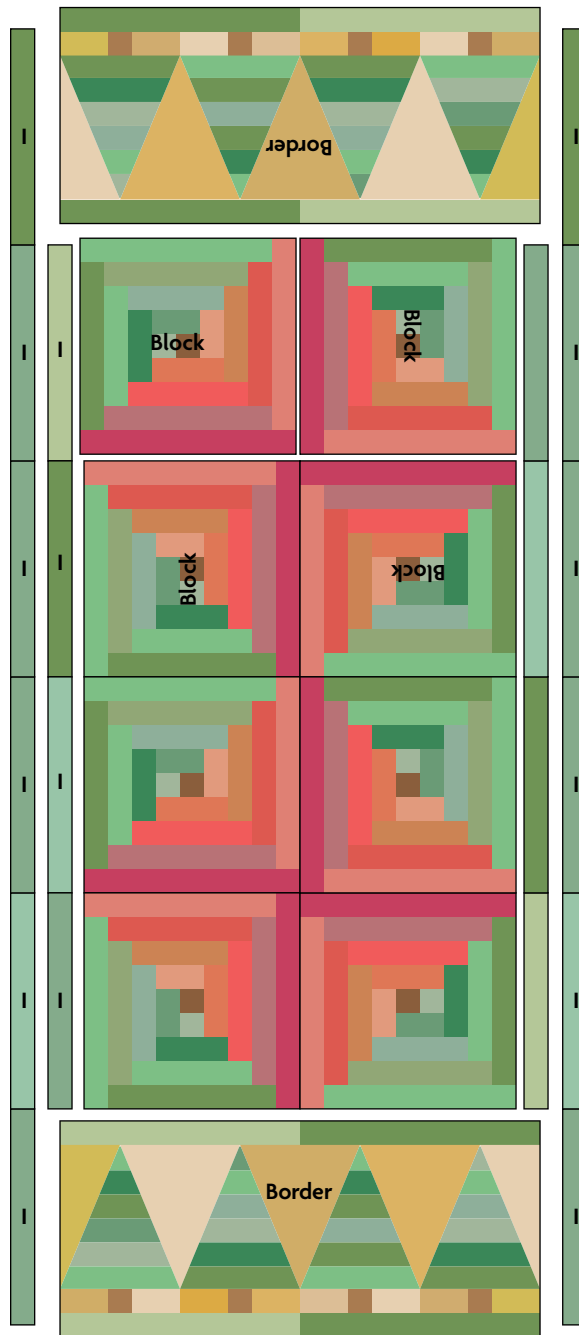
BAND DIAGRAM

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ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
