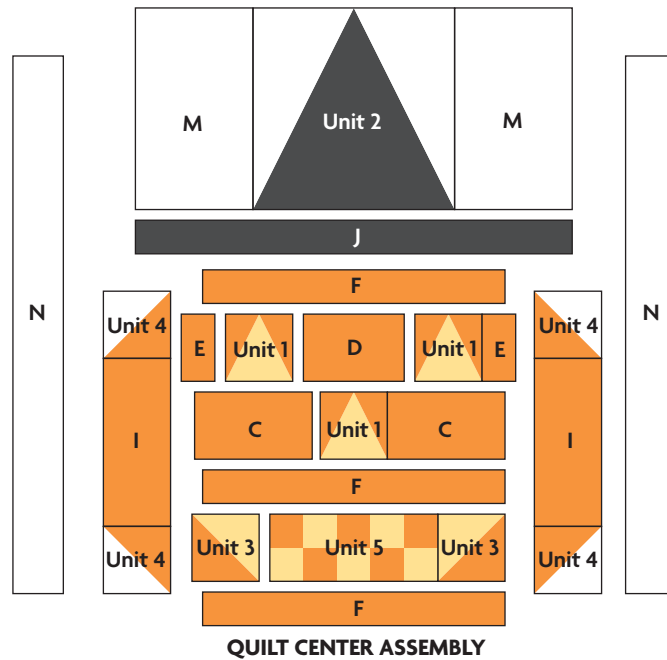
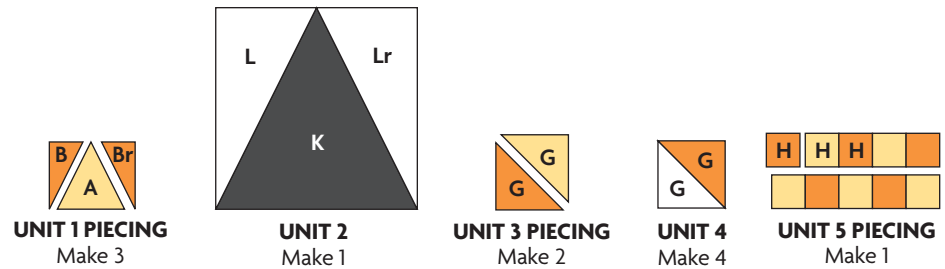


Ghosts and bats, owls and skeletons, black cats and haunted houses—all this and more surround this smiling Jack-O-Lantern created especially for QN readers by Jason Yenter to showcase his Hallowgraphix collection from In the Beginning Fabrics. His border print gives the look of a pieced border without any stitching. What could be easier?

ASSEMBLY

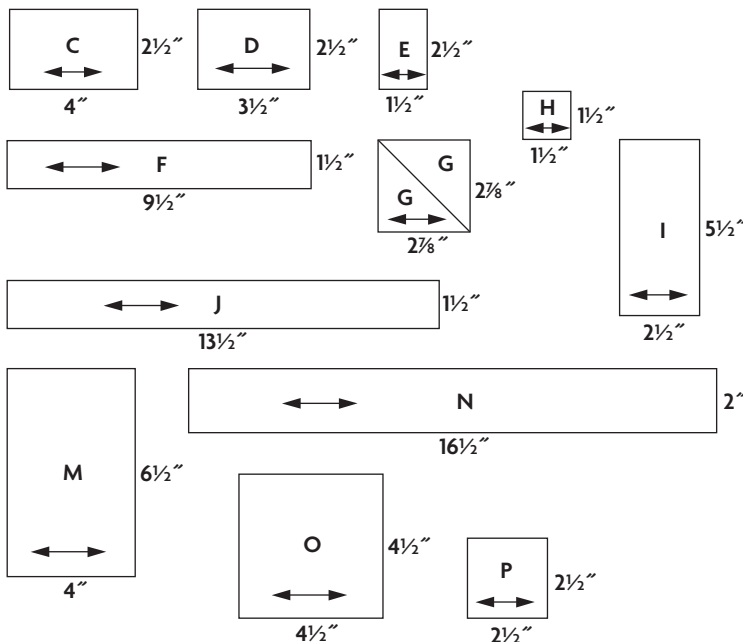
1 Wash, starch, and press fabrics. Make templates for A, B/Br, K, and L/Lr. Cut all the patches and strips listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams. Cut Br and Lr patches with the templates face down on the right side of the fabrics.

2 Referring to the unit 1 piecing diagram, join a B and a Br to opposite sides of an A to make a unit 1. Make 3. In the same manner, join the L and the Lr to opposite sides of the K as shown in the unit 2 diagram. Referring to the unit 3 piecing diagram, join an orange G to a yellow G to make a unit 3. Make 2. In the same manner, join an orange G and a black and white G as shown in the unit 4 diagram. Make 4. Finally, join the H's as shown to make a unit 5. Referring to the quilt center piecing diagram, join the patches and units as shown to complete the quilt center. ▶



ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.



MATERIALS AND CUTTING

Requirements are based on 41" fabric width. Borders are cut lengthwise. Border measurements include 2" extra plus seam allowance for insurance.

QUILT SIZE: 37" x 37"

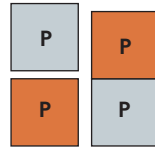

Yellow	fat $\frac{1}{8}$	3 A, 2 G, 5 H
Orange	fat $\frac{1}{4}$	3 B, 3 Br, 2 C, 1 D, 2 E, 3 F, 6 G, 5 H, 2 I
Black	fat $\frac{1}{4}$	1 J, 1 K
Black and White	$\frac{1}{2}$	4 G, 1 L, 1 Lr, 2 M, 2 N
Print	$\frac{1}{3}$ *	10 O
Gray Leaf	fat $\frac{1}{4}$	20 P
Orange Spider	fat $\frac{1}{4}$	20 P
Border Print	$\frac{1}{4}$	4 borders 7" x 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
Binding	$\frac{1}{3}$	4 strips 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 41"
Backing	$1\frac{1}{8}$	41" x 41"
Batting		41" x 41"

*Purchase extra yardage as needed for fussy cutting.

ALSO NEEDED: template plastic

TECHNIQUES USED: machine piecing, mitered borders, machine quilting

3 Referring to the four patch piecing diagram, join 2 orange spider P's and 2 gray leaf P's. Make 10 four patches. Referring to the quilt assembly diagram, join 2 four patches and 2 O's to make the left inside border. Repeat to make the right inside border, noting the placement of the four patches and O's. Join the side borders to the quilt center. Referring to the quilt assembly




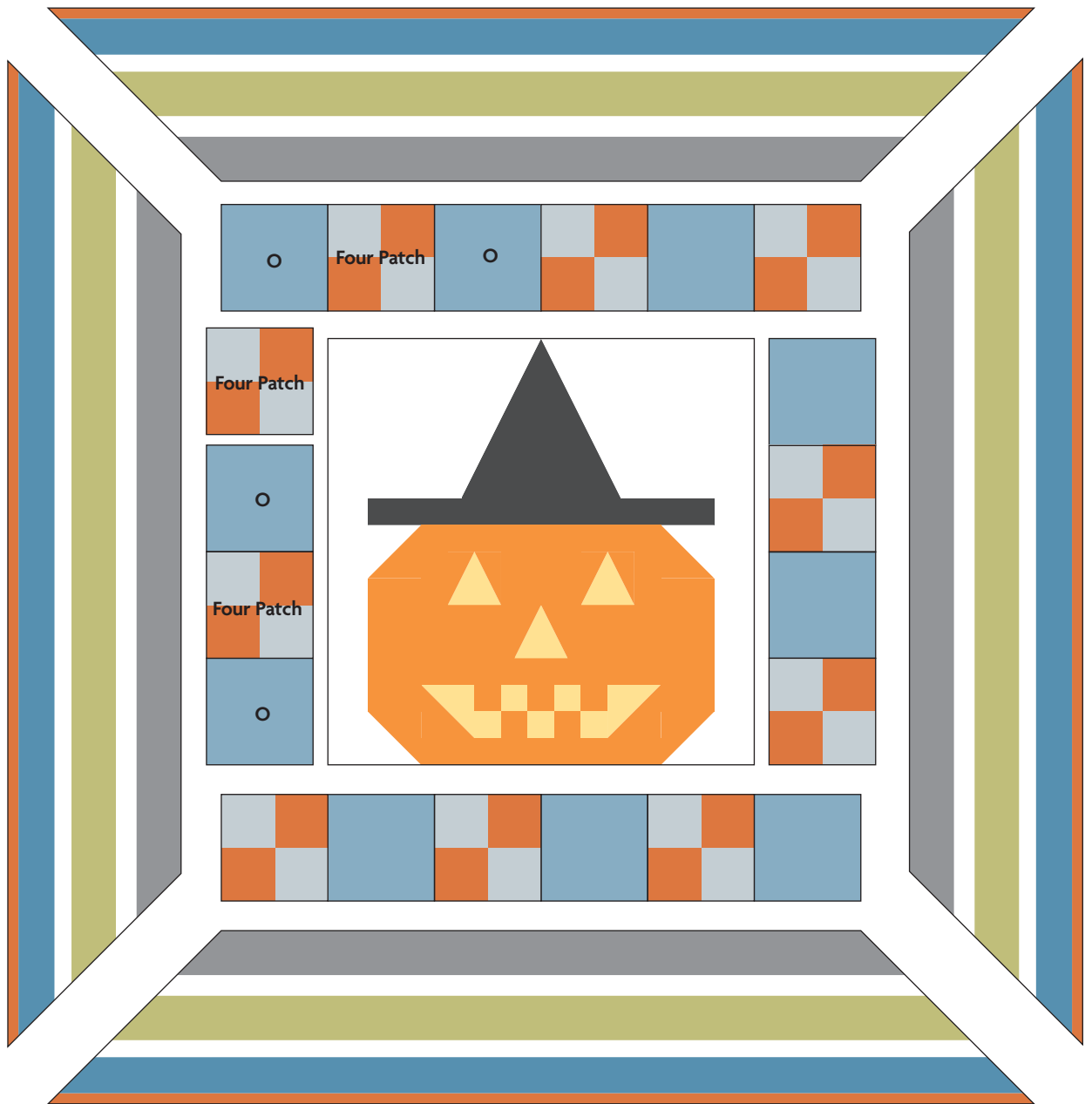
FOUR PATCH PIECING

diagram, join 3 O's and 3 four patches to make the top inside border. Repeat to make the bottom inside border, noting the placement of the four patches

and O's. Join the top and bottom borders to the quilt center.

4 Join a print border to each side of the quilt, starting and stopping stitching $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the corners. Miter the borders. Trim the seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press them open.

5 Layer and baste the quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind the quilt to finish.
