



In the Pink Table Runner

This table runner by Patricia Bravo of Art Gallery Quilts, Hollywood, Florida, is a great place to use some of your scraps. Find a color family that works for you and start sewing together strips. Add the optional lattice for a fun finishing touch.

ASSEMBLY

■ Wash, starch and press fabrics. Cut the patches as listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams. ▶

MATERIALS AND CUTTING

Requirements are based on 42" fabric width. Borders are cut crosswise and pieced and are the exact length required plus seam allowance.

BLOCK SIZE: 7½"	QUILT SIZE: 20" x 65½"
MATERIALS	YDS. CUTTING
Dark Pink Prints	1⅛* 2 borders 1" x 47½", 2 borders 1" x 18½", 6 lattice strips 2½" x 42" (optional), 2 A, 10 B, 8 C, 14 D, 8 E
Medium Pink Print	¼ 2 borders 1½" x 48½", 2 borders 1½" x 20½"
White/Light Pink Prints	½ 2 borders 1½" x 45½", 2 borders 1½" x 17½", 4 A, 6 B, 2 C, 4 D
Binding	⅓ 4 binding strips 2¼" x 40"
Backing	1⅞ 24" x 54"
Batting	24" x 54"

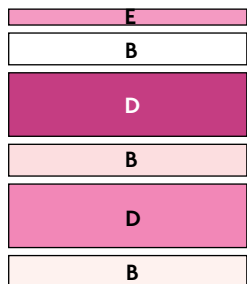
*If you chose not to make the lattice trim, you will need ¾ yard of dark pink prints.

TECHNIQUES USED: machine piecing, machine quilting, lattice trim (optional)

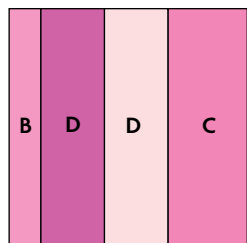
DESIGNER TIP

LATTICE TRIM

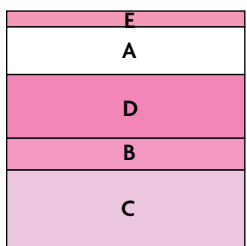
Fold the lattice strips lengthwise, right sides together. Stitch along the long raw edge to make a tube. Turn the tube right side out and press flat. Cut 4 strips 20½" long and 10 strips 8¼" long. Turn in ¼" on each end. Stitch the ends closed. On the back side of the table runner, space the 8¼" strips across the width of the table runner and stitch in place. Referring to the quilt photo, weave the 20½" strips in place and topstitch to secure.



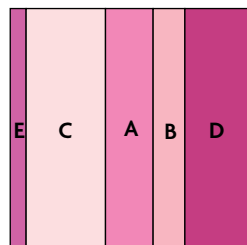
BLOCK W PIECING

2 Referring to the block W piecing diagram, join 3 B's, 2 D's and 1 E to make a block W. Make 2. In the same manner and referring to the block diagrams, make 4 block X's, 4 block Y's and 2 block Z's.

3 Referring to the quilt assembly diagram, arrange the blocks in 6 rows of 2 blocks each, rotating the blocks as shown. Join the blocks in rows then join the rows.

4 Join the 1½" x 45½" white/light pink borders to the sides of the quilt. Join the 1½" x 17½" white/light pink borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. In the same manner, join the 1" x 47½" dark pink borders to the sides of the quilt. Join the 1" x 18½" dark pink borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Join the 1½" x 48½" medium pink borders to the sides of the quilt. Join the 1½" x 20½" borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

5 Mark quilting motifs as desired. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste. Quilt as marked or as desired. Bind the quilt.

ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
