

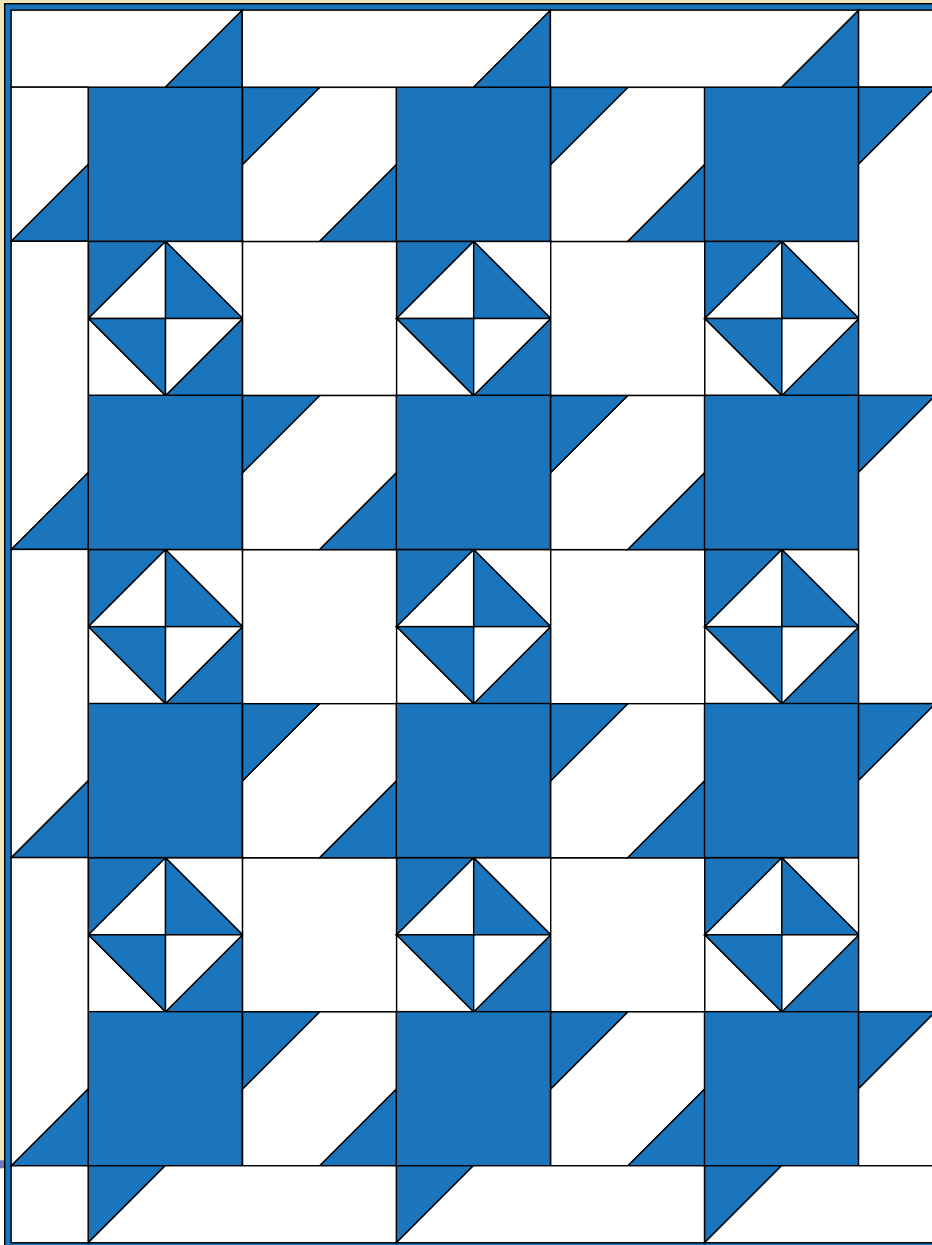
# Soul

QN FREE PATTERN  
DESIGNED BY KELLY M. SMITH



**Simple shapes make stars shine in this wall quilt.**

This is a fast, easy-to-piece pattern. Make all the stars in one color for the ultimate in simplicity or use complementary colors for a stunning design. The original quilt, *Ici, une âme* by Nelly Lanoue, is based on a mosaic tile work pattern found in the Alhambra Palace in Grenada, Spain.



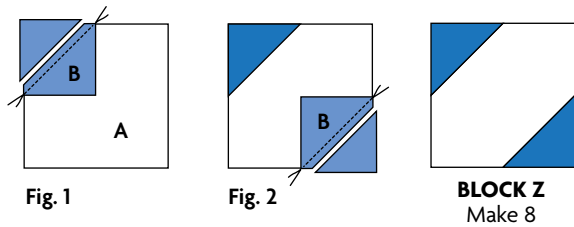

Make 8

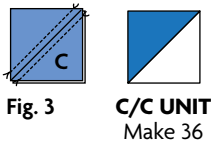
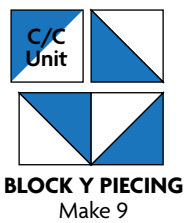

### ASSEMBLY

**1** Wash and press fabrics. Cut the patches and binding strips listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.

**2** Referring to Fig. 1, place a B on an A, right sides together. Stitch diagonally as shown. Trim the seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press the seam open. Repeat with another B on the opposite corner of the A as shown in Fig. 2 to make a block Z. Make 8. Referring to Fig. 3, layer one white C and one blue C with right sides together. Draw a diagonal line as shown. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from either side of the line. Cut along

the line and press the C/C units open. Make a total of 36 C/C units. Referring to the block Y piecing diagram, join 4 C/C units to make a block Y. Repeat to make 9 block Y's.

**3** Referring to Fig. 4, place a B on a D, right sides together, and stitch diagonally as shown. Trim the seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press the seam open. Make 2 border unit 1's. Referring to the remaining diagrams, make 4 border unit 2's, 6 border unit 3's, and 2 border unit 4's in the same manner.

**4** Join the border units as shown in quilt assembly diagram to ▶

### MATERIALS AND CUTTING

Requirements are based on 40" fabric width.

**BLOCK SIZE:** 6"      **QUILT SIZE:** 36" x 48"

MATERIALS	YDS.	CUTTING
White	1½	14 A, 2 B, 18 C, 2 D, 10 E, 2 F
Blue	1¼	12 A, 30 B, 18 C, 5 binding strips 2¼" x 40"
Backing	1½	1 panel 40" x 52"
Batting		40" x 52"

**TECHNIQUES USED:** machine piecing, machine quilting

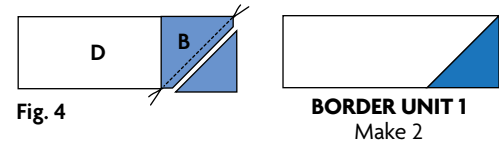
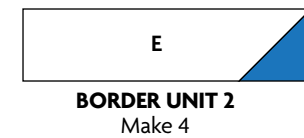
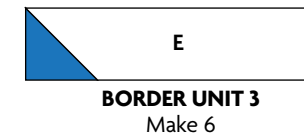

Make 4



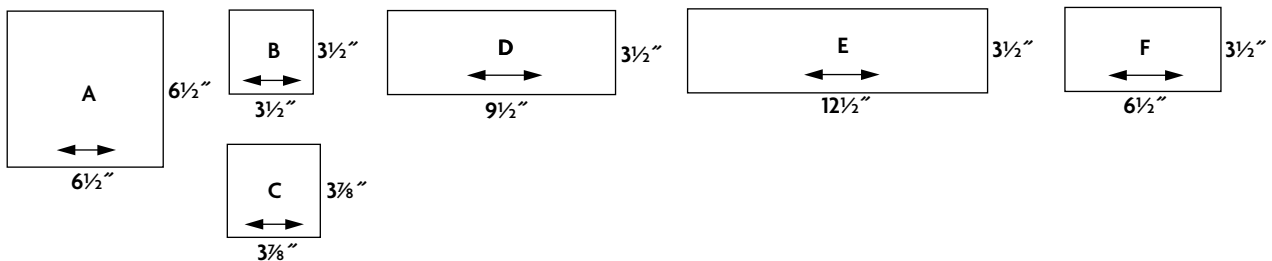
**BORDER UNIT 3**  
Make 6

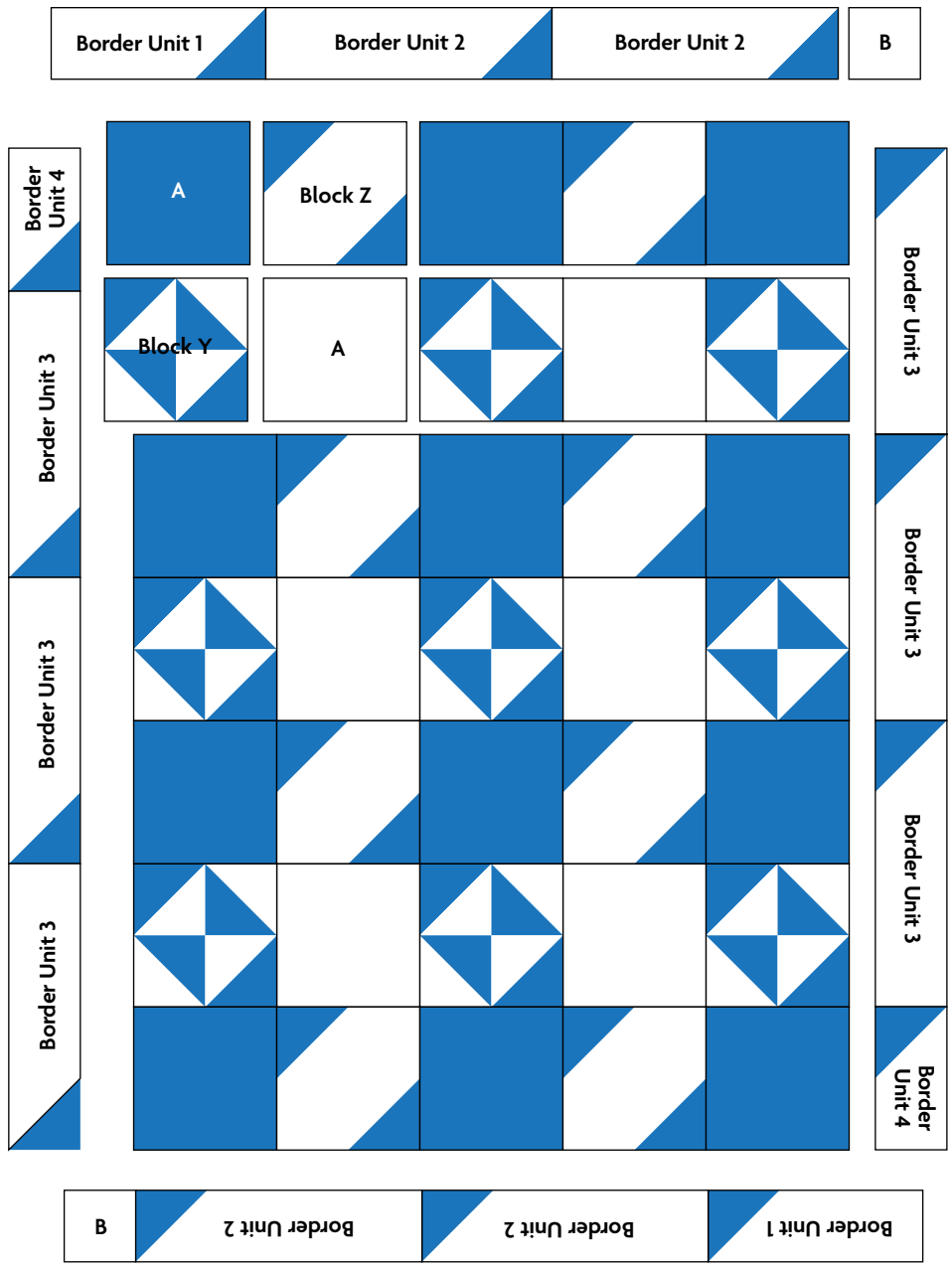


**BORDER UNIT 4**

### ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.





**QUILT ASSEMBLY**

make the borders. Referring to the quilt assembly diagram, arrange the blocks, patches, and borders as shown on a design wall or large, flat surface. Join the blocks and patches into rows. Join the rows. Attach the side borders first, matching seams, and then join the top and bottom borders in the same manner.

**5** Layer the backing, batting, and top. Baste. Quilt as desired. Bind the quilt to finish.
