

Spinning Monkey

Wall Hanging

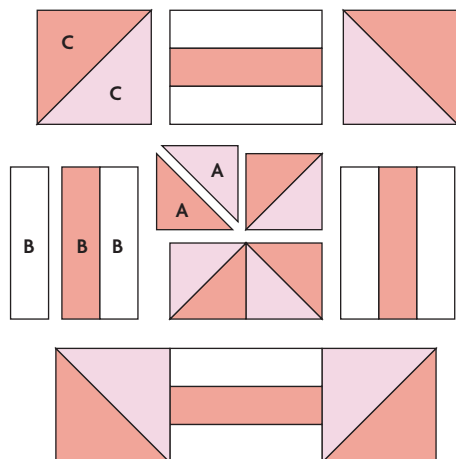
For many years QN staffers have been creating free patterns for our readers to celebrate spring, QN's birthday, and Christmas. Our current offering is this four-block wall hanging designed by editor Patricia Heath. Choose a palette of creamy pastels for a springtime treat, or stitch a valentine in red, white, and pink. Monkey Wrench and Pinwheel blocks were the inspiration for this appealing 10" block design.

ASSEMBLY

1. Wash and press fabrics. Cut the patches and strips listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.

2. Referring to the block W piecing diagram, join 4 red A's to 4 pink A's to make 4 squares. Paying attention to color placement, join the squares to make a pinwheel. Join 1 white B to each long side of 4 red B's to make 4 rectangles. Join 4 red C's to 4 pink C's to make 4 squares.

3. Referring to the block W piecing diagram for correct color placement, join the pinwheel, squares, and rectangles to complete block W. Make 2. ▶

MATERIALS AND CUTTING

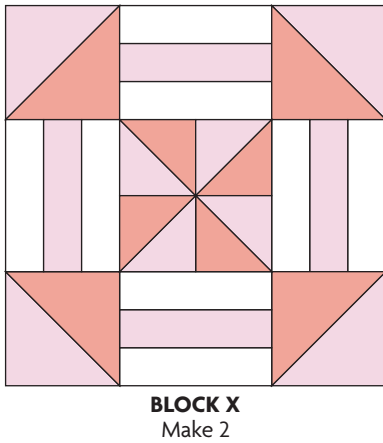
Requirements are based on 40" fabric width.

BLOCK SIZE: 10" **QUILT SIZE:** 20" x 20"

MATERIALS	YDS.	CUTTING
Red	¼	16 A, 8 B, 16 C
Pink	¼	16 A, 8 B, 16 C
White	¼	32 B
Backing and binding	¾	1 panel 24" x 24" for backing, 4 strips 2¼" x 24" for binding
Batting		24" x 24"

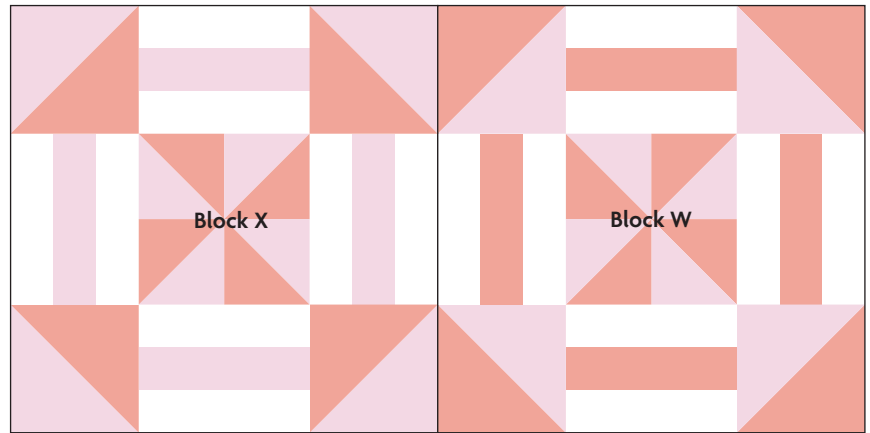
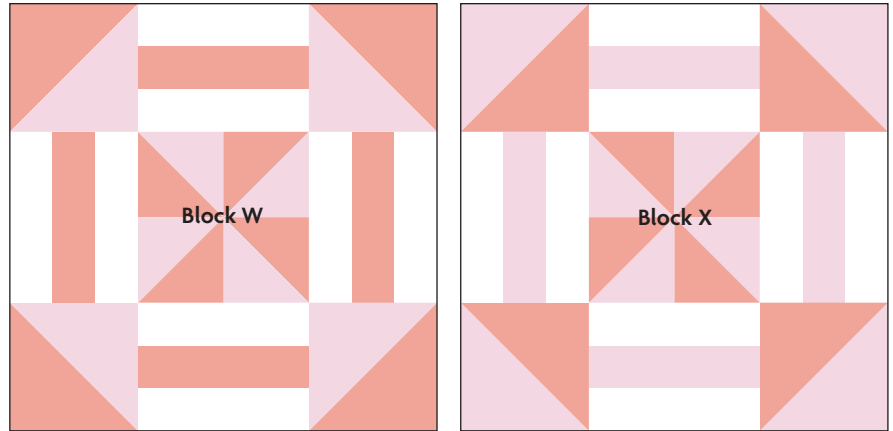
TECHNIQUES USED: machine piecing, machine quilting

4. Referring to the block X diagram for correct color placement, follow steps 2 and 3 to complete block X. Make 2.



5. Referring to the quilt assembly diagram, join 2 block W's alternately with 2 block X's as shown.

6. Layer the quilt backing, batting, and top. Baste. Stitch in the ditch around the patches and blocks. Bind the quilt to finish.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
