

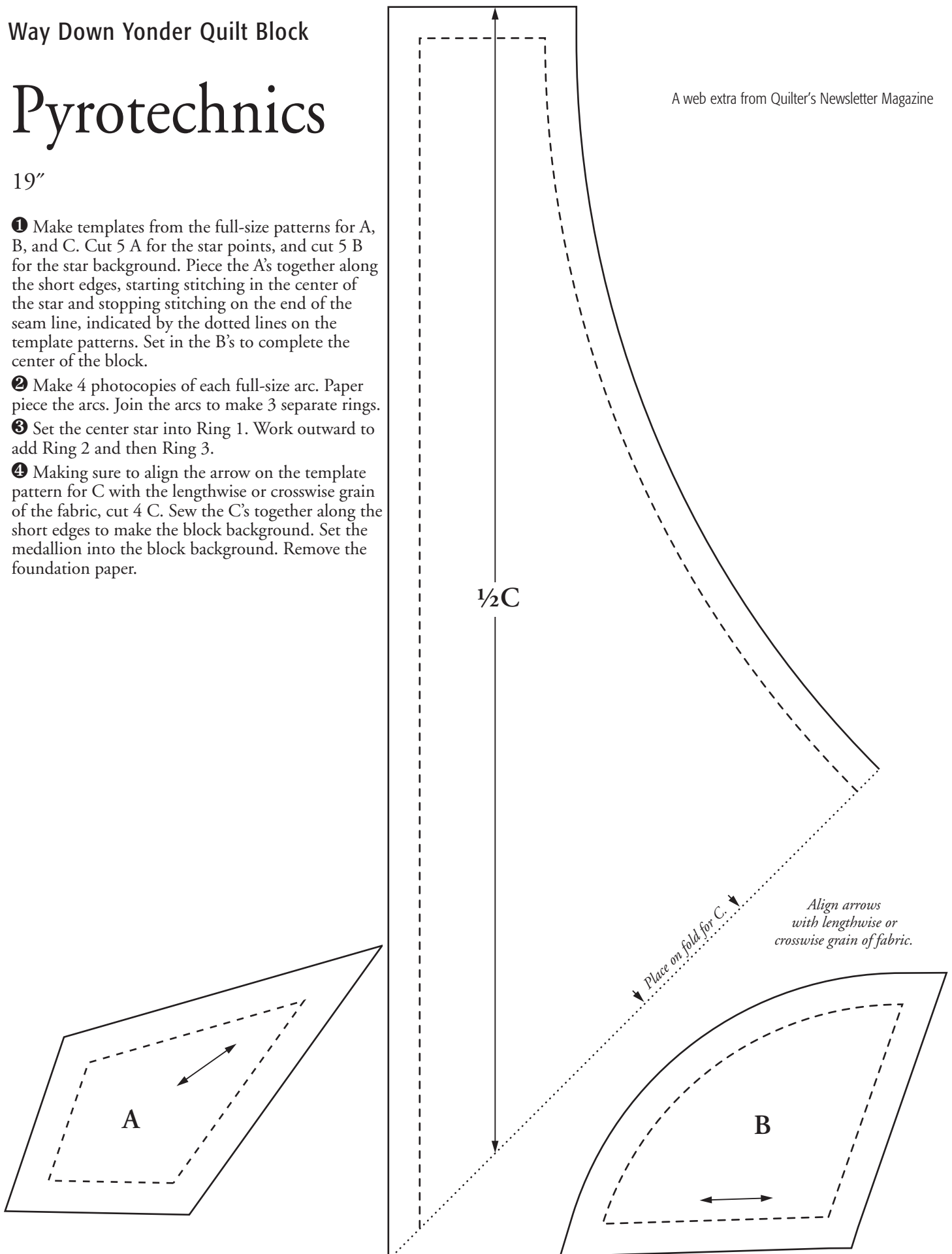
## Way Down Yonder Quilt Block

# Pyrotechnics

19"

- 1 Make templates from the full-size patterns for A, B, and C. Cut 5 A for the star points, and cut 5 B for the star background. Piece the A's together along the short edges, starting stitching in the center of the star and stopping stitching on the end of the seam line, indicated by the dotted lines on the template patterns. Set in the B's to complete the center of the block.
- 2 Make 4 photocopies of each full-size arc. Paper piece the arcs. Join the arcs to make 3 separate rings.
- 3 Set the center star into Ring 1. Work outward to add Ring 2 and then Ring 3.
- 4 Making sure to align the arrow on the template pattern for C with the lengthwise or crosswise grain of the fabric, cut 4 C. Sew the C's together along the short edges to make the block background. Set the medallion into the block background. Remove the foundation paper.

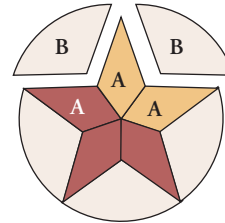
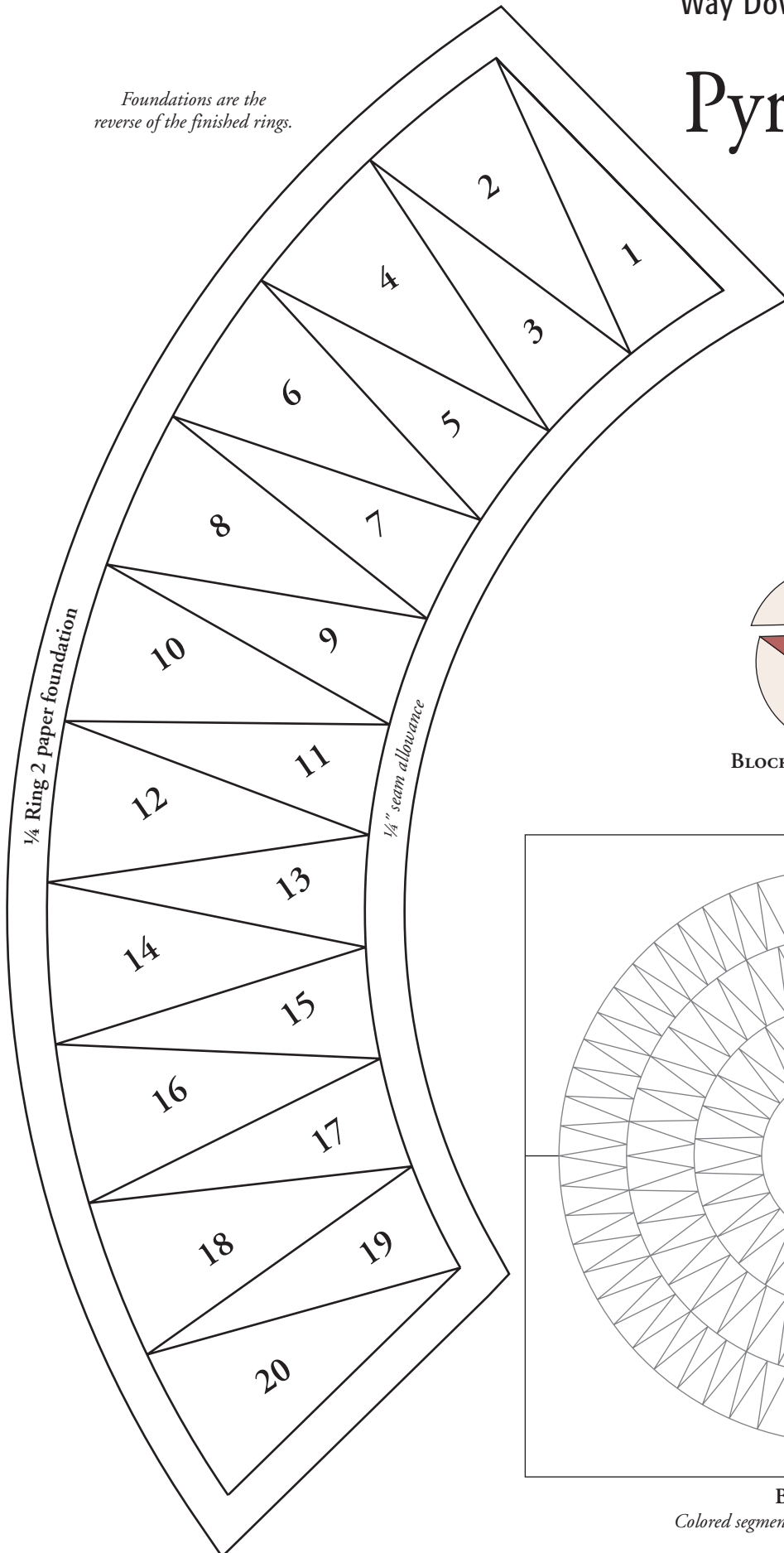

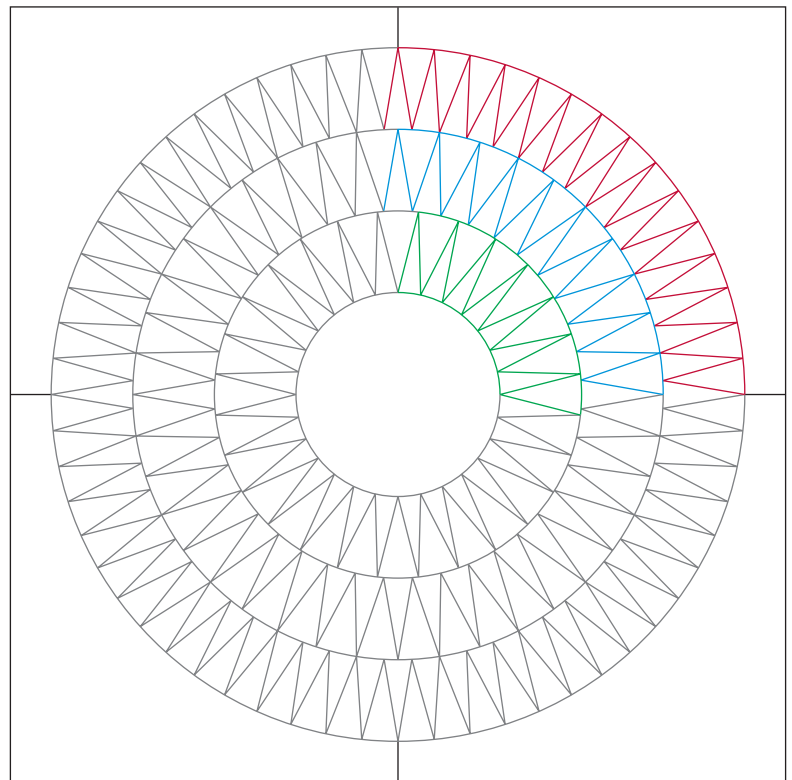
# Pyrotechnics
