# Rosy Garden Patch

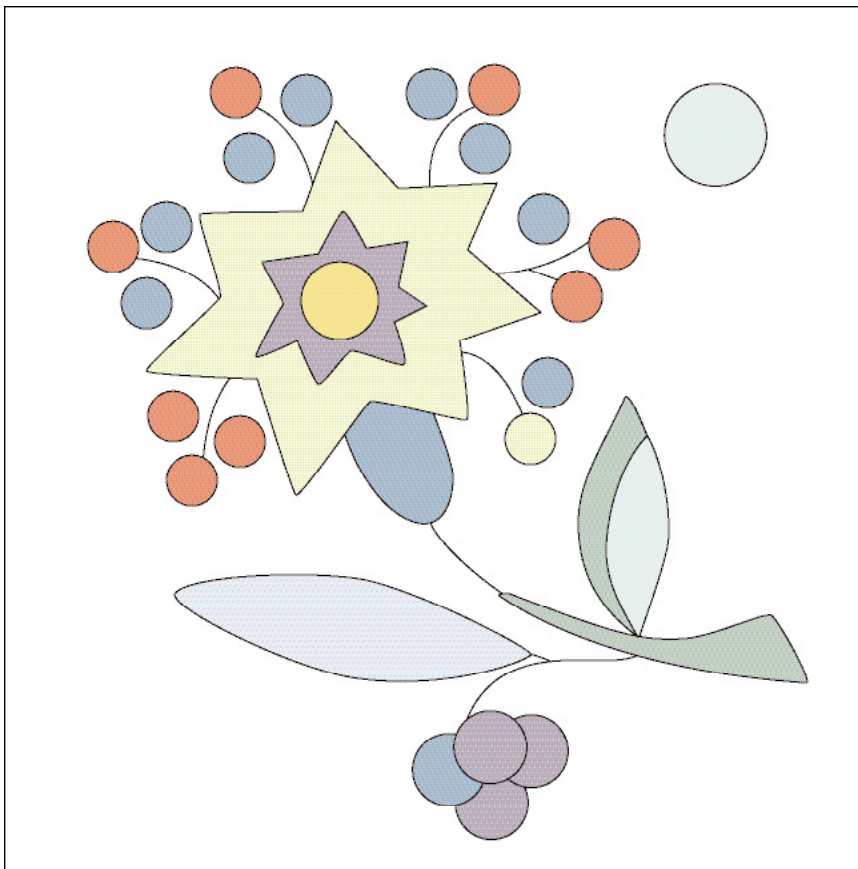

The cover quilt in *Quilter's Newsletter Magazine* issue 393 was designed and made by Judith Thompson of Wenonah, New Jersey. Four blocks and applique for the border were given in the issue. Here are two more of Judith's applique motifs and directions for the skinny fabric stems.



**Star Flower:** *Fussy cut circles of fabric for the patches around the flower. For the two-color leaf, sew the dark green patch to the cream fabric along the center edge. Cut the leaf as one piece and applique in place. Embroider the fine stems with outline stitches.*



*Enlarge motif 200% for full-size applique.*

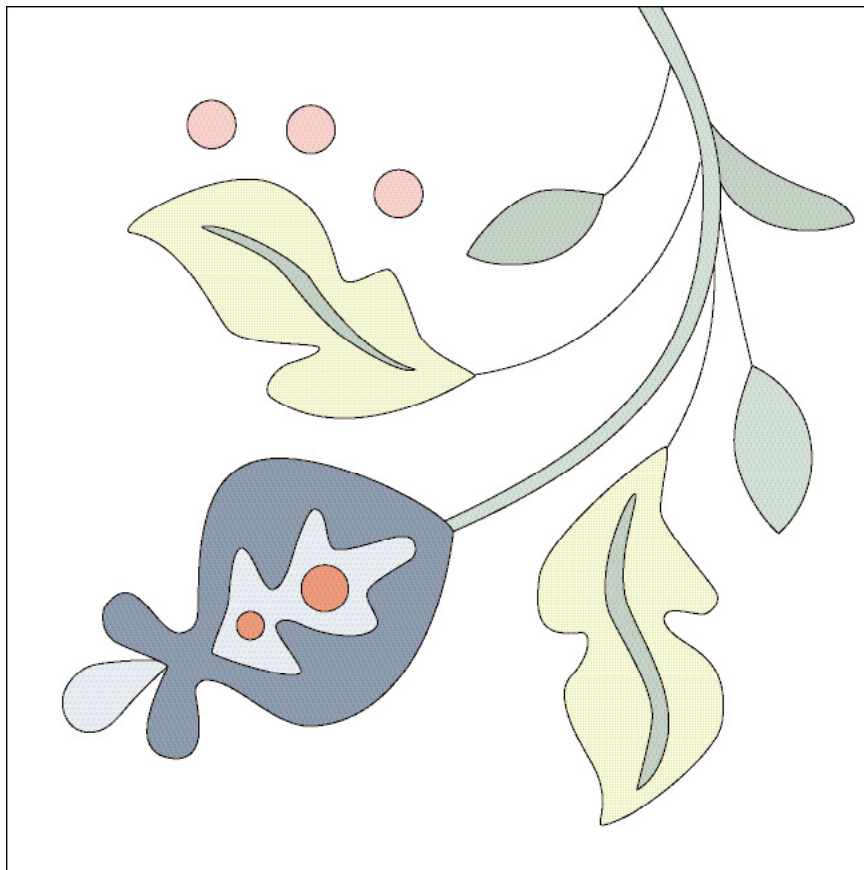
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**Pomegranate Flower:** *Use reverse applique techniques to stitch the veins on the large leaves. Fussy cut the circles from novelty prints. Embroider the fine stems with outline stitches.*
