

Miss Kitty

This is the fifth installment of patterns and instructions for the art quilt on the back of Janine Holzman's *Miss Kitty*. The pattern for the front of the quilt appeared in the May 2007 issue of *Quilters Newsletter*. The small strippy quilt on the back is made with blocks that Janine stitched or collected. The patterns for each of the vertical rows are being given in seven installments on this website.

Row 5: Applique Posies

Cut a cream background strip 5" x 42½". Cut 2 medium print sashes each 1¼" x 42½" and sew them to the long sides of the cream strip.

Prepare a bias vine that finishes ¾" wide and that is approximately 52" long. Referring to the quilt photograph, arrange and stitch the vine on the cream strip.

Prepare the flowers and leaves for your favorite method of applique. These raw-edge flowers on Janine's quilt are finished with a machine blanket stitch and black thread. Arrange the flowers and leaves along the vine as you wish and fuse and/or stitch them in place.

Sew this row to the rows from the previous installments.
