

# Chestnut

In the July/August 2008 issue of *Quilters Newsletter*, Chestnut, a versatile pattern designed by Susan Geddes, is presented. A quilting motif, designed exclusively for this pattern, is also provided. The full-size Chestnut Blossom motif is given here in several sections because it is quite large. Print each section on an 8½" x 11" sheet of paper and tape the sheets together for the full-size motif.

We've provided the yardage requirements here for the blue and orange batik version shown in "Take Two."

## TAKE TWO

### MATERIALS AND CUTTING

Requirements are based on 40" fabric width.

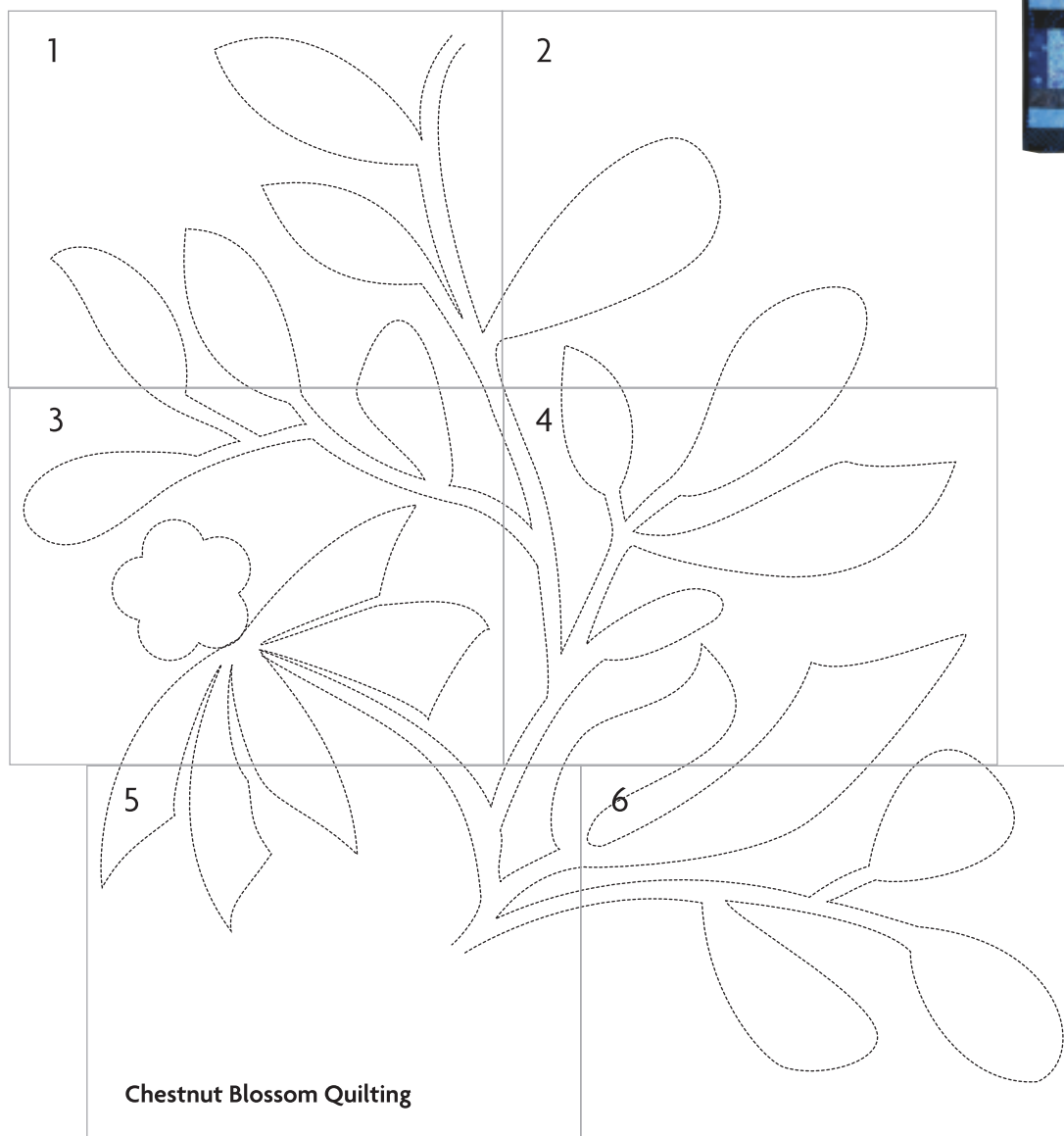
**BLOCK SIZE:** 9"

**QUILT SIZE:** 63" x 81"

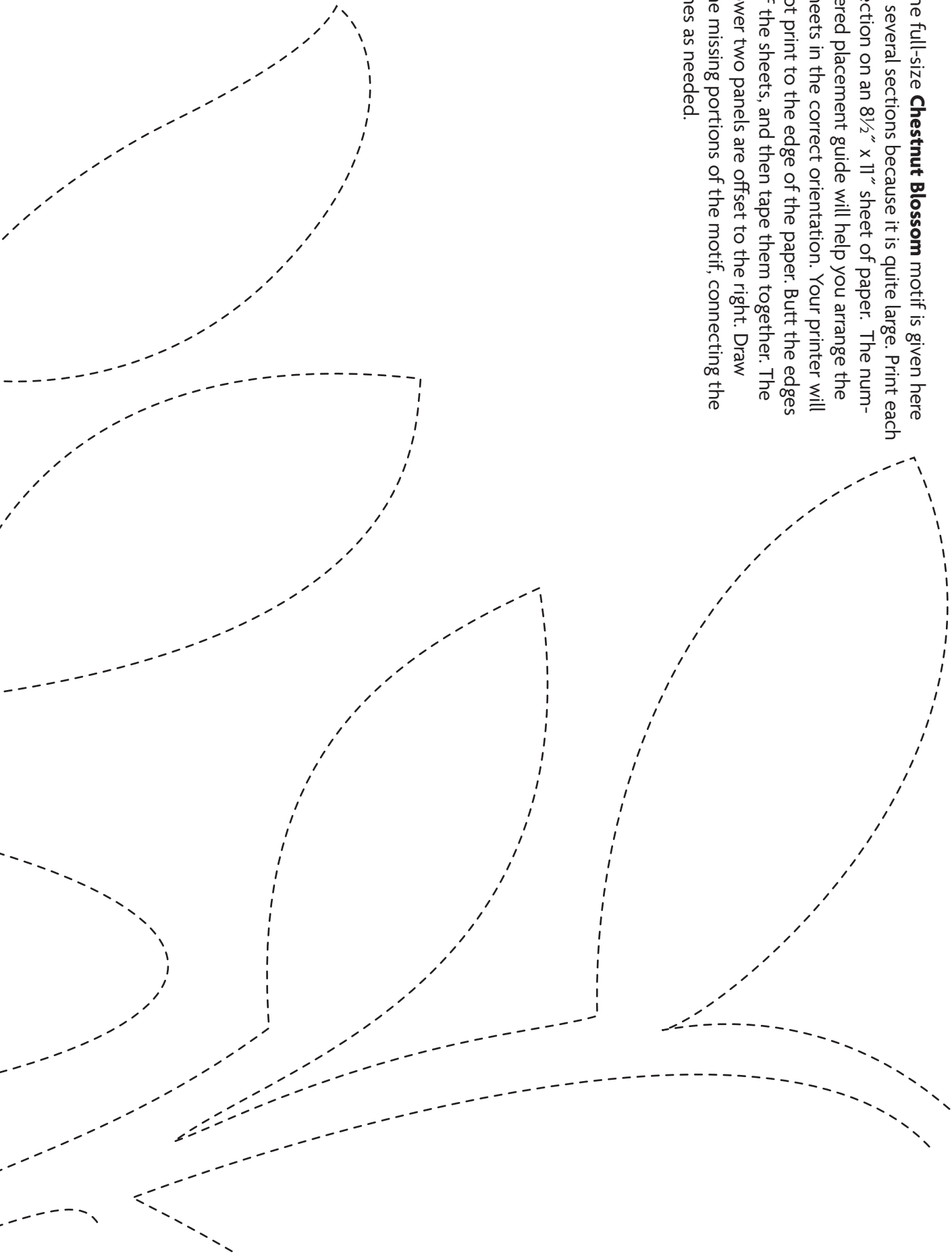
MATERIALS	YDS.	CUTTING
Orange Batiks	¾	63 A
Dk. Blue Batiks	4¾	*1,008 B or 92 strips 1½" x 40", 8 strips binding 2¼" x 40"
Light Blue Batiks	2½	504 B or 46 strips 1½" x 40"
Backing	5	2 vertical panels 34" x 85"
Batting	4" wider and longer than quilt top	

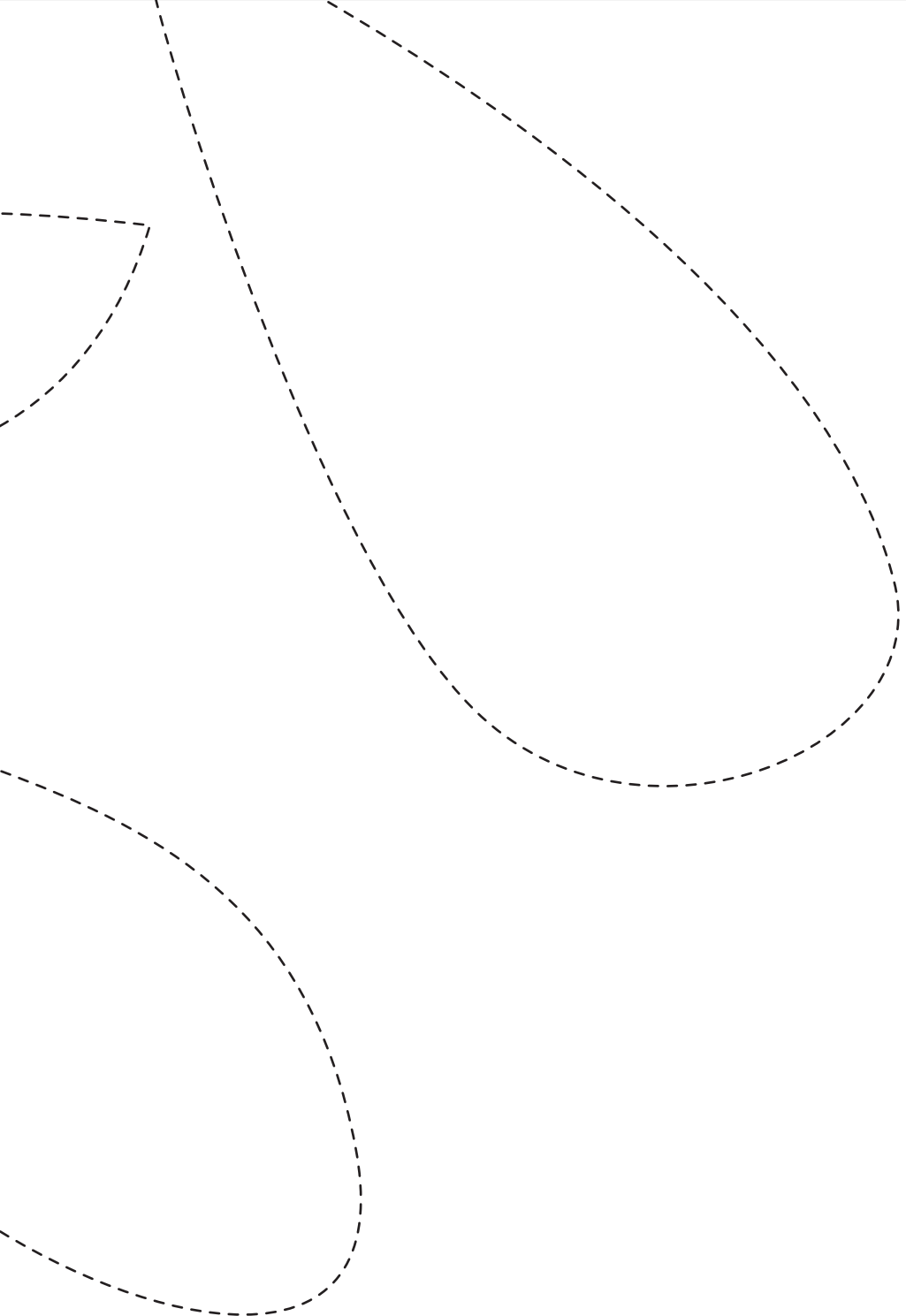
\*Read step 1 before cutting fabrics.

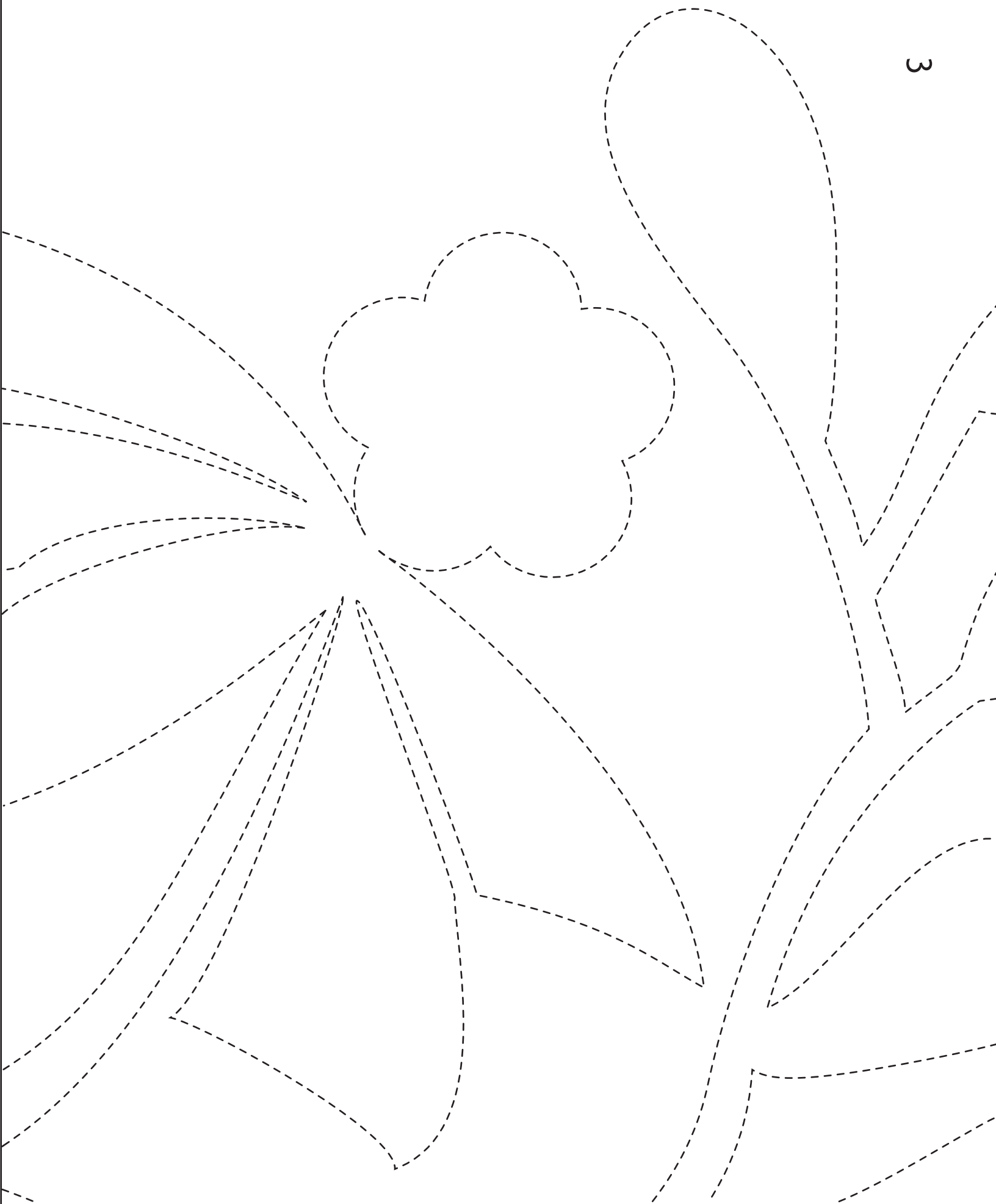
**TECHNIQUES USED:** strip piecing or machine piecing, hand or machine quilting, pieced binding

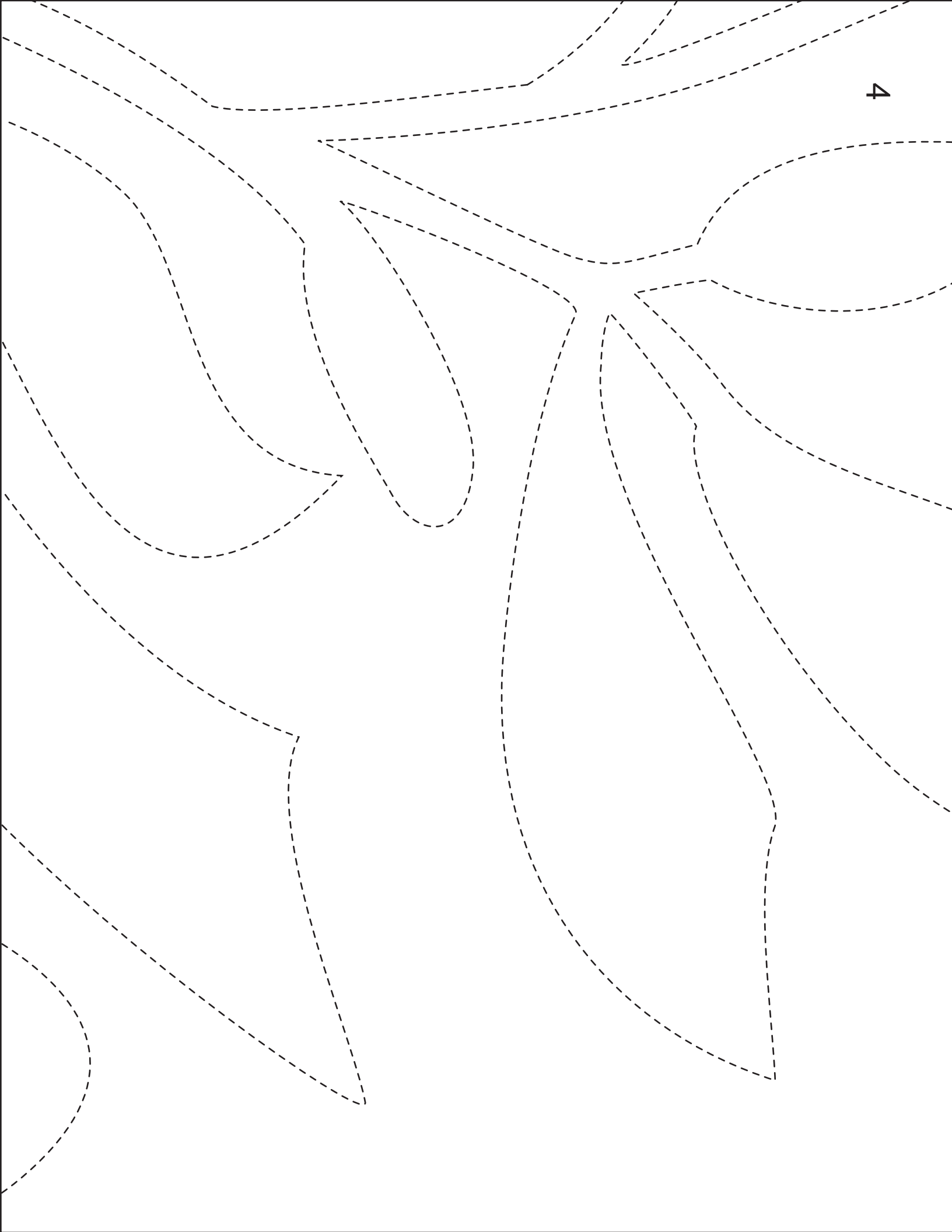


The full-size **Chestnut Blossom** motif is given here in several sections because it is quite large. Print each section on an 8½" x 11" sheet of paper. The numbered placement guide will help you arrange the sheets in the correct orientation. Your printer will not print to the edge of the paper. But the edges of the sheets, and then tape them together. The lower two panels are offset to the right. Draw the missing portions of the motif, connecting the lines as needed.

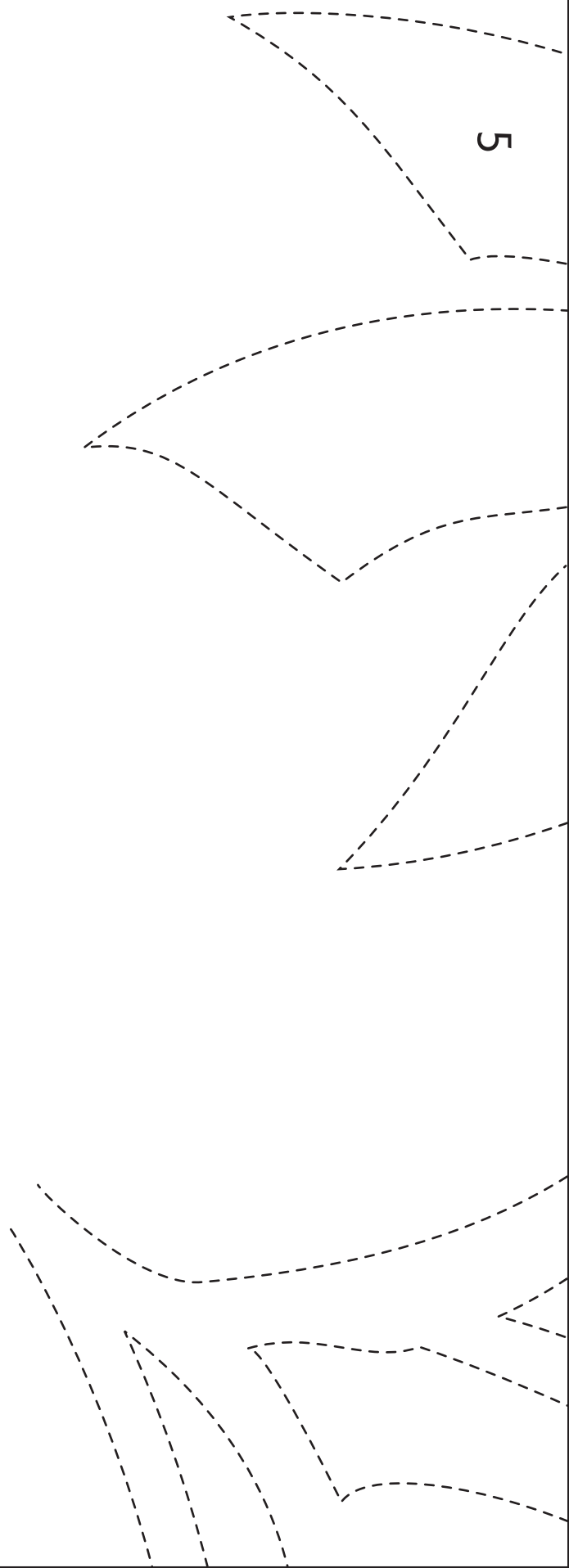


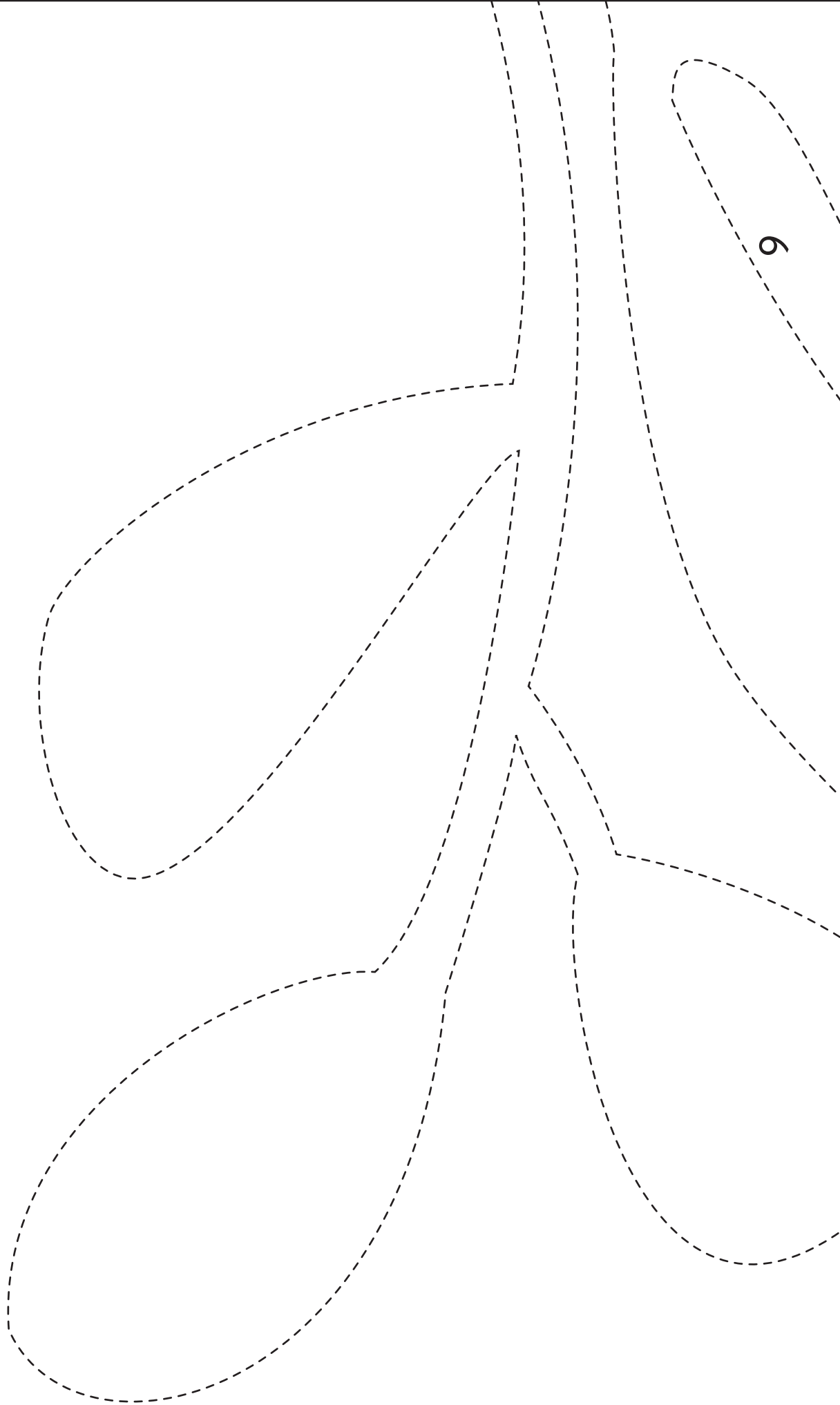






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
